**SHOULD ASSIGNMENT NOT BE PROPERLY MADE, THIS WARRANTY IS VOID.**

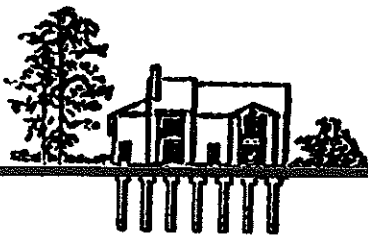


