Section 3.

The condo ("Property") is located on the top third floor of a multi-condo complex building facing Buffalo Bayou. Flood insurance is not currently required on the individual condo unit for financing purposes due to its elevation nor has it ever flooded. The first floor underground basement parking (which faces the bayou) did flood with ~5-6 feet of water for the first time since the structure was built in 1967. The building and condo was accessible during the storm because the main building entrances are at street level which did not flood. During the storm, the building generally did not lose electricity, water or air conditioning and all streets in the Kerry Glen gated community were accessible to Woodway.

The three-story multi-condo structure is located in the 100-year flood plain. The HOA maintains flood insurance on the building structure and its common areas. The elevator between the 3 floors however was damaged from the flood and has been repaired and upgraded.

The HOA is responsible for roof repairs. There were two minor roof leaks after some major storms that stained some sheetrock on the condo ceiling that was repaired by the HOA in 2016.

Section 5.

Common facilities include the buildings, equipment, grounds and landscaping, a guard gate, recreational areas, pool and laundry facilities, elevators, a chiller system, water facilities and central laundry facilities among other items. The HOA is responsible for maintenance of all the common facilities.

The monthly assessment includes building property insurance (including owner's interior buildouts for fire as defined in the policy), common area taxes, security, maintenance and repairs to all the common facilities as well as all utilities including electricity, gas, water, sewer and cable services. The condo, however, is one of a few condos in the complex that has its own HVAC system and individual air controls and therefore not part of the central chiller system. The owner is responsible for the maintenance of this individual HVAC system, however, the HOA pays all electricity.

There has never been a special assessment since the building was built in 1967.
