2000

- Complete remodel of the house walls, including new exterior breaker box, interior/exterior electrical and wiring. Two GFCI outdoor outlets, one front and one rear.
- Three water outlets with hose connections added, one front and two rear—make watering a breeze.
- Foundation leveled as near as practical by pier and beam expert James Pfister.
- Blown insulation added to the attic, which is well lit and partially decked for easy access to the regularly maintained HVAC.
- Sheetrock over existing shiplap and relocation of original doors for the bedroom, bath and laundry closet. Crown molding in the kitchen. Stainless steel sink and Formica countertops.
- New Whirlpool dishwasher
- Hampton Bay ceiling fans installed in LR and BR with matching custom light kits.
- Pedestal sink and marble shower in bath. Original stained glass window installed in shower.
- ADA Compliant assist rails at shower entrance and inside stall.

2001

- Fenced in front yard with wrought iron and lockable gate, covered in unique vine which has never frozen and blooms with beautiful purple flowers in the spring, summer and fall. Natural, easy to maintain front and rear landscaping includes a beautiful, flowering Catalpa tree which shades the whole house from the summer's heat.
- In addition, the house sports a stunning pecan tree on the west side and there are several large shade trees along the rear property line wooden fence.
- House was tented for dry wood and subterranean termites. No signs of visible activity at that time but the house had been spot treated some years earlier. The property is inspected once a year for subterranean and wood destroying termites. Always clear; evidence of previous damage does not affect the structure of this fine example of an English Cottage.
- 30-year roof decked with 3/4 inch plywood and shingled.

2005

• 10 glass panel solid wood french doors added between the kitchen and dining room with a custom top latch to close.

2006

• Period correct rear access 10 glass panel solid wood door installed.

2007

- All existing wood siding was removed and the frame of the house wrapped in Tyvek insulation then Hardie-planked and painted with a lifetime warranty. Great care was taken to remove and replace the original front porch and window trim.
- All windows replaced with double hung JELD-WEN window packs, double paned and energy efficient. These windows were carefully chosen to match the original design.

- Custom front yard cedar swing and trellis.
- Custom Cherokee stone laid in front yard area and side driveway.

• Partial new fencing in back on the west side of the house with a built-in privacy gate for access to the rental property next door (when the house is unoccupied) for lawn maintenance, tree trimming, or other necessities as needed.

2014

• New high-efficiency two-stage 3 ton digital \$15000 HVAC system with whole house filter and surge protector added.
