

Our home was built in 1976 and not until Harvey did it flood. Even during the Labor Day floods our home did not flood. It did not even reach our street curb on that day. Harvey was biblical, but even so it only came up 11 inches, staying below the electrical plugs. Our lights never went out. The flood waters receded quickly when the rain stopped and we immediately began to demolish the sheet rock, doors/frames and anything permeable that the water touched. We even replaced the tub. We put dehumidifiers and high powered fans through out the house as soon as the water was gone. We also treated the affected areas during the drying out. Once dry, we sprayed in foam insulation to replace the old insulation. There was never any mold as a result of the flood as we worked fast to dry out our home. We were lucky to have so many friends that helped us remediate our home, hours after the flood waters receded.
