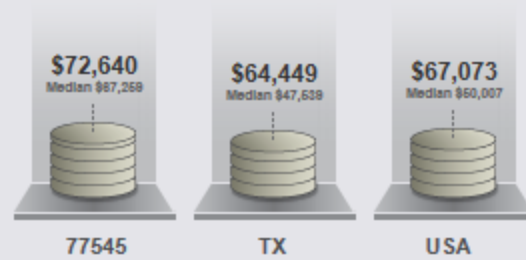
77545 is an affluent area with a younger population in Fresno, Texas.

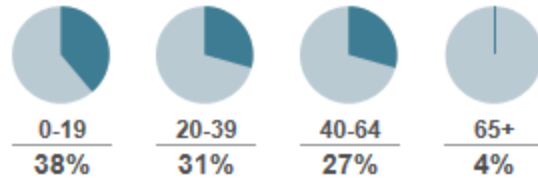
