- Lamar Consolidated High School, established in 1949, is the flagship high school in Lamar CISD and will celebrate 70 years of excellence in 2019.
- LCHS was selected to be part of the first campus-level cohort with the prestigious Holdsworth Center.
- Project Lead the Way offers LCHS students the opportunity to experience the technology, biomedical and engineering fields.
- LCHS houses the District's only commercial aquaponics lab and fully-functioning automotive technology center onsite.
- Weekly MUSTang Time offers students intervention and/or enrichment opportunities that provide both academic and emotional support.
- LCHS has a full-time College and Career Facilitator on campus to support students reaching their post-secondary goals.
- In 2007, the LCHS Mustangs Football team won the 4A, Division I State Championship.

- Lamar CISD has sixth-grade only campuses (middle schools) which focus on the needs of pre-adolescents, providing a smooth transition to secondary schools;
- College facilitators are on every high school campus, helping all students learn about college opportunities, scholarships, applications and more.

FINANCES

- Lamar CISD has one of the lowest tax rates in the area at \$1.39—this tax rate has remained flat for eight straight years;
