My water bill appears higher than normal - what should I do?

- Check to see if your commode continually runs after flushing
- Check irrigation system operation / time settings / valve & head leaks
- Check to see if your water heater is leaking
- Check all indoor & outdoor faucets for leaking or dripping
- Check yard for water pooling indicating unknown leaking pipes or fittings
- Check pool systems & large outside water features for leaks
- Check all appliances & equipment connected to water, for leaks
