- 2) The bottom of the house was closed in 2001, to make it a 4 bedroom 3 bathroom home
- 3) We started remodeling the home in October 2018 and finished in April of this year. No one has lived in the home since October 2018.
- 4) We have replaced the entire roof, 2 ac units and all of the ductwork, all the flooring, paint inside and outside, all the doors interior and exterior, new vanities and toilets as well as custom self closing kitchen cabinets and pantry. We have replaced all the light fixtures.
- 5) We built the carport in March of 2019. We wanted to give the new home owners the opportunity to build it out to their needs here in this neighborhood we all have a lot of toys that needs specific space.
- 6) The house sits on almost 1/2 acre. The house is about 2800 sq feet.
- 7) HOA is \$ 125.00 per year.
- 8) The home has never flooded. We have been here through 2 hurricanes and have not had any flooding even houses across the street have not experienced flooding.
