Neighborhood Highlights

The Heights Hike and Bike Trail- The Heights Hike and Bike trail is mere second away and offers over 20 miles of paved path along White Oak Bayou for walkers, runners, and bikers. This trail also provides easy access to downtown and the Metro Line, which is a definite plus when you want to get to NRG stadium for a game or show at the rodeo without dealing with traffic.

Cafeza—Cafeza is a local popular coffee shop (and wine/cocktail bar in the evening) that's two blocks away, making it an easy walk even in summer. The café not only has delicious coffee, but their in-house churros and tacos are great for weekend brunch. They also host popular jazz nights if you're looking for a change of pace!

Spring Street Beer and Wine Garden—This is a great beer/wine/cocktail bar across the street with a great outdoor patio area. You can catch the game here, but during the week they frequently have theme nights such as Loteria (Bingo) and Steak Night. People are often surprised to learn they hold Sunday morning outdoor yoga classes as well, making this an all-around good neighborhood hangout.

Platypus Brewing—This is nearby brewery that focuses on Aussie style beer. It features both in- and out-door seating and has a moderate sized dining menu for when you want more. They are dog and small child friendly, so you get a nice mix of people here.

2nd Saturday at Sawyer Yards-- On the second Saturday of each month, the art studios of The Silos, Silver Street, Winter Street and Summer Street Studios open to the public for free. Wandering through repurposed warehouses to find a variety of art, jewelry, photography, clothing, textiles, and more is a great way to spend a Saturday afternoon.
