HORSESHOE BEND HOMEOWNERS ASSOCIATION LAKE USAGE GUIDELINES FOR HORSESHOE BEND LAKE

Following are the guidelines for the use of Horseshoe Bend Lake adopted by the Horseshoe Bend Homeowners Association on March 30, 2019.

- 1. No water skiing, jet skis, houseboats or air boats will be permitted upon the Lake.
- 2. Boats shall not be driven at a speed in excess of 10 mph upon the Lake. Boat operators should make every effort to minimize the wake created by their boat in order to help prevent the erosion of our lake's shoreline and damage to docks and moored watercraft.
- 3. No dumping of any materials is permitted into the Lake.
- 4. No stationary rafts shall be permitted on the Lake.
- 5. No boats shall be launched from a trailer except from the boat launch area located at the lakeside common area.
- 6. The lock at the boat ramp is to remain locked at all times except when launching or loading. The combination to the lock should not be shared with anyone for any reason.
- 7. All boats should have a Horseshoe Bend registration sticker displayed on both sides of the bow when in the Lake. Owners of guest boats should obtain and display a guest pass in their boat when it is in the Lake.
- 8. No trotlines, jug lines or set lines are allowed. No netting or commercial fishing shall be allowed on the Lake.
- 9. Catch and release largemouth bass.
- 10. Utilize barbless hooks on all soft plastic lures and live bait.
- 11. Catch and release all crappie caught and all bream over 7" length.
- 12. Children under 13 should wear a life jacket at all times when on the Lake.
