"500-year floodplain" means any area of land that: (A) is identified on the flood insurance rate map as a moderate flood hazard area, which is designated on the map as Zone X (shaded); and (B) has a two-tenths of one percent annual chance of flooding, which is considered to be a moderate risk of flooding.

"Flood pool" means the area adjacent to a reservoir that lies above the normal maximum operating level of the reservoir and that is subject to controlled inundation under the management of the United States Army Corps of Engineers.


The seller is not aware of any condition on the property that may affect safety or health of an individual.

The seller is aware of a condition in the easement leading to the property that could possibly present a safety/health hazard.

An electric service meter pole in the easement provides service to an RV and storage used as living quarters next to the easement. Electric service from the meter pole to the RV and building was not buried and runs on top of the ground across the easement. 4/4SOOW insulated and jacketed service line was used. There is some potential for a safety/health hazard if wear and tear to the service line continues.

This issue is not considered a permanent service line but there is currently no specified date it will be corrected. Entergy services the area electric and has been notified in writing and conversations with Entergy on this matter have taken place. We are looking for a resolution soon.
