- W No tar paper. unfinished sheet metal or similar material shell be exposed on a period in excess of two months.
- j. All the exterior of all buildings under construction must be completed, including trim and paint, within 120 days from start of construction.
- ů All residences must be connected into a cewer-soptic tank system meeting PHA requirements for a building of the size and intended use. All sewage and waste water must be disposed into the system and not be allowed to overflow above ground or drain into the road ditches. No outdoor tollets shall be allowed. All sewage and septic systems must comply with all applicable regulations of the faxes Department of Health and all other applicable Pederal, State or local rules, fexas Department of Health and all other applicable Pederal, regulations and ordinances.
