The decks allow plenty of space for letting the kids play but having a separate deck for adults.

The school bus stops at the corner just 1 house away.

The water stays 3-5 feet deep all year depending on rain. We have jet skis and have never had a problem with getting them in and out.

There is space in the garage for the extra freezer and fridge.

The whole house water filter and water treatment system were replaced in 2019. The roof is new in 2013.

We are adding a few incentives for the buyer. Flooring is a personal touch so we are adding a \$2500.00 flooring add on, \$1000.00 towards a refrigerator, \$500.00 towards a freezer in the garage, and \$300.00 for landscaping, and \$700.00 towards moving cost.
