- Two recreation centers, each with swimming pools and playgrounds: 321 Westover Park Avenue (RC #1) and 631 Westover Park Avenue (RC#2).
- Two lighted tennis courts, also set up for Pickle Ball play.
- A key is required for access to the tennis courts. The key is \$15 and can be requested by completing the <u>Request For Tennis Court Key</u> and mailing it to Associa with a check payable to Westover Park Community Association for \$15. The key is then mailed to the resident. Assessments must be paid current in order to purchase a key.
- A Challenge Course Park with a Pro fitness course located at Hamilton and Livingstone Lanes
- Open sports field to be used for soccer, general field type uses, outdoor parties
- Numerous parks and playgrounds throughout the community
- The pools are managed by a professional lifeguard company and are open weekends in May, full time 6 days a week during the summer and weekends through September - schedule is set based on the school district calendar. Pools are only open when lifeguards are on duty. See <u>Facility Hours</u> for more information.
- Pools can be rented for private parties, outside of the published community swim schedule, from May through September. The Pool Rental Policy can be found here. There is a rental fee and a lifeguard fee for private parties. Regarding requests for private pool parties please go to the website at gulfcoastaquatics.com then click on the Private Party tab and follow the instructions. Information and rates are provided on that tab. Inquiries are processed in the order received. Email inquires will be responded back to the sender asking the sender to go the website. Your assessments must be paid current in order to request a private party.
- Access to the community pools is by a colored wrist band, issued annually by
 the Association through GCA. The registration schedule is published in late
 spring with dates for registration at Recreation Center #1 in May. All other
 registration is required to be done at GCA's office. There is no charge for
 wristbands, and they are only distributed to members residing in the
 home. Guests are permitted at the pools but must be accompanied by a
 resident with a current wristband. The current form to obtain wrist bands can
