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ARTICLES OF ENGINEERINATION

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PANIOUST POURST PROPERTY GREEKS ASSOCIATION, INC.

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, being natural persons of the age of twenty-deal (21) There or more, at least two of whom are citizens of the State of Texas, acting as mission or store of a corporation under the Texas Hon-Profit Corporation Act, do hareby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation of such corporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is "Farkway Forest Property Owners Association, Inc."
hereinafter called the "Association."

ARTICLE II

The Association is a non-profit corporation.

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ARTICLE III

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

The purpose or purposes for which the Association is formed are to provide for maintenance, preservation and architectural control of the residence lots and Campon Area within that certain tract of property described as that certain subdivision known as PARKWAY POREST, SECTION ONE, in Harris County, Texas, and to promote the health, safety, and welfare of the residents within the above-described property and any edditions therete as may be a brought within the jurisdiction of the Association for these purposes, and to:

- (a) exercise all of the powers and privileges, and to perform all of the duties and obligations of the Association as set forth in that certain Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions, hereinafter called the "Declaration," applicable to the property and recorded or to be recorded in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds for Harris County, Texas, and as the same way be amended from time to time as therein provided, said Declaration being incorporated herein as if set forth at length;
- (b) fix, levy, collect and enforce payment by lawful means, all charges or assessments pursuant to the terms of the Declaration; to pay all expenses in connection therewith and all office and other expenses incident to the conduct of the business of the Association, including all licenses, taxes or

popernmental charges levied or imposed against the property of the Association

- (c) sequire (by gift, purchase or otherwise,) own, hald, improve, hadld upon, operate, maintain, coursey, sell, lease, transfer, deficate for public affairs of the Association;
- (d) borrow money, and with the assent of two-thirds (2/3) of each class of numbers, nortgags, pledge, deed in trust, or hypothecate any or all of its real or personal property as security for money horrowed or debts incurred;
- (e) dedicate, sell or transfer all or any part of the Common Area to easy public agency, authority, or utility for such purposes and subject to such conditions as may be agreed to by the numbers. No such dedication or transfer shall be effective unless an instrument has been signed by two-thirds (2/3) of each class of members, agreeing to such dedication, sale, or transfer;
- (f) participate in mergers and consolidations with other nomprofit corporations organized for the same purposes or amen additional residential
 property and Common Area, provided that any such surger, consolidation or
 ammenation shall have the assent of two-thirds (2/3) of each class of members;
- (g) have and to exercise any and all powers, rights and privileges which a corporation organized under the Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of Texas by law may now or hereafter have or exercise.

ARTICLE V

Every person or entity who is a record owner of a fee or undivided fee interest in any Lot which is subject to covenants of record to assessment by the Association, including contract sellers, shall be a member of the Association. The foregoing is not intended to include persons or entities who hold an interest merely as security for the performance of an obligation. Hembership shall be appurtenent to and may not be separated from ownership of any Lot which is subject to assessment by the Association.

ARTICLE VI

The Association shall have two classes of voting membership:

Class A: Class A members shall be all Owners, with the exception of the Declarant, and shall be entitled to one vote for each Lot owned. When more than one person holds an interest in any Lot, all such persons shall be members. The vote for such.

Let shall be exercised as they among themselves determine, but in no event shall more than one vote be cast with respect to any Lot.

Class B: Class B mesher (a) shall be the Duclaruet (as defined in the bi tice), and shall be entitled to those (3) votes for each let enmed. The Class B becatily shall cease and be converted to Class A memberskip on the happening of either of the fallowing events, whichever occurs earlier:

- (a) then the total votes extension in the Class A mediucakip. equal the total votes enterming in the Class B membership; or
- (b) on December 31, 1976.

ARTICLE VII

The affairs of the Association shall be managed by a Board of five (5) directers, who need not be members of the Association. The number of directors may be changed by assendment of the By-Laws of the Association. The names and addresses of the persons who are to act in the capacity of initial directors until the seloction of their successors are:

At the first annual meeting, the members shall elect one director for a term of one year, two directors for terms of two years, and two directors for terms of three years, and at each annual meeting thereafter the numbers shall elect directors for terms of three years, as needed.

ARTICLE VIII

The post office address of the initial registered office of the Association is 11947 Tidwell Boad, Houston, Texas 77044, and the name of its initial registered sgent is Moward W. Edmunds, at this address.

ARTICLE IX .

The Association may be dissolved with the assent given in writing and signed by not less than two-thirds (2/3) of each class of members. Upon dissolution of the Association, other than incident to a merger or consolidation, the assets of the Association shall be dedicated to an appropriate public agency to be used for purposes similar to those for which this Association was created. Jin the events a that such dedication is refused acceptance, such assets shall be granted, conveyed, and assigned to any nonprofit corporation, association, trust or other organization to be devoted to such similar purposes.

METICLE I

Annuluses of three Articles shall require the assent of 75 percent (75%) of the suction annharming.
