

## 0.4307 acre of land in the Thomas B. Bell League, Abstract No. 41, Brazoria County, Texas

A FIELD NOTE DESCRIPTION of a 0.4307 acre (18,761 square feet) tract of land in the Thomas B. Bell League, Abstract No. 41, Brazoria County, Texas; said 0.4307 acre tract being out of Tract 48 & 49 of the San Bernard Syndicate Subdivision, according to the map or plat recorded in Volume 2, Page 135 of the Brazoria County Plat Records, also known as "Lot 5" and "Lot 6" conveyed to Caroline Macik, as recorded in the Brazoria County Clerk's File No. 2012025017 and further described in deeds recorded in Volume 1366, Page 355 and Volume 1143, Page 87 of the Brazoria County Deed Records; said tract being more particularly described by metes-and-bounds as follows with the bearings being based on Texas State Plane Coordinate System, South Central Zone (NAD83) per GPS Observations using National Geodetic Survey Continuously Operating Reference Stations:

BEGINNING at a 1/2-inch iron pipe found in the northeast right-of-way line of County Road 819-C (Down River) (60 feet wide) for the west corner of said "Lot 6" and for the south corner of "Lot 7", conveyed to Ralph T. Primeau and wife, Arlene S. Primeau, as recorded in Brazoria County Clerk's File No. 96-013217 and for the west corner of this tract; from which a 1/2-inch iron rod found bears North 61° 20' 40" West – 19.29 feet;

THENCE, North 41° 42' 58" East with the southeast line of said "Lot 7" and with the northwest line of said "Lot 6", at a distance of 183.44 feet pass a 1/2-inch iron pipe found and continuing for a total distance of 192.86 feet to a point in the called "water's edge" of the San Bernard River for the east corner of said "Lot 7", for the north corner of said "Lot 6" and for the north corner of this tract;

THENCE, South 58° 58' 30" East - 100.09 feet with the called "water's edge" of the San Bernard River and with the northeast line of said "Lot 5" and "Lot 6" to a point for the north corner of "Lot 4", conveyed to Matthew Robert Cone, as recorded in Brazoria County Clerk's File No. 2008010189, for the east corner of said "Lot 5", and for the east corner of this tract;

THENCE, South 41° 42' 26" West with the northwest line of said "Lot 4" and with the southeast line of said "Lot 5", at a distance of 10.12 feet pass a 1-inch iron pipe found and continuing for a total distance of 188.60 feet to a 5/8-inch iron rod with cap stamped "TEAM" set in the northeast right-of-way line of said County Road 819-C for the west corner of said "Lot 4", for the south corner of said "Lot 5", and for the south corner of this tract; from which a 1-1/4-inch iron pipe found bears South 61° 20' 40" East – 100.82 feet;

THENCE, North 61° 20′ 40″ West with the northeast right-of-way line of said County Road 819-C and with the southwest line of said "Lot 5", at a distance of 50.44 feet pass a 1/2-inch iron rod found for the west corner of said "Lot 5" and for the south corner of said "Lot 6" and continuing with the northeast right-of-way line of said County Road 819-C and with the southeast line of said "Lot 6" for a total distance of 100.99 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 0.4307 acre (18,761 square feet) of land.

Note: This metes-and-bounds description was compiled in conjunction with a survey performed on even date.
