- Additional projects include:
- Elevation of First Street bridge to allow better flow of water out of the city & into the
- Willow Fork branch of the Buffalo Bayou
- Riceland Terrace has completed dig outs of ditches to restore capacity
- Riceland Terrace ditches will be converted to modern storm sewers
- 6401 Magnolia Street improvements:
- French drains added
- Yard drains installed to take gutter runoff directly to concrete reinforced ditch
