## AMENDMENT TO RESTRICTIVE COVENANTS AND CONDITIONS COVERING HICKORY CREEK PLACE

THE STATE OF TEXAS KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: COUNTY OF BRAZORIA

WHEREAS heretofore, on or about the 12th day of January, 1966 Olin G. Wellborn, Jr., being the then owner of those certain tracts and parcels of land situate in Brazoria County, Texas known and described as follows:

Hickory Creek Place, a Subdivision of 100.09 acres of land, being a Subdivision of Tracts 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 30, 31, 32, 33 and 34, HT&B RR Company Survey, Section 7, Abstract 219, Brazoria County, Texas, according to the Plat of said Hickory Creek Place recorded in Volume 11 at Pages 1 and 2 of the Plat Records of Brazoria County, Texas;

did make and place certain Restrictive Covenants and Conditions upon said land, which Restrictive Covenants and Conditions appear of record in Volume 930 at Page 439 et seq of the Deed Records of Brazoria County, Texas; and,

WHEREAS the undersigned are presently the owners of all of said aforesaid described land and desire and intend by this instrument to amend the aforementioned Restrictive Covenants and Conditions;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, Olin G. Wellborn, Jr., Tom H. Lee and wife, Fairy Ann Lee, Harold D. Moore and wife, Alice L. Moore and James Elvin McKaughan and wife, Sharon F. McKaughan, do for ourselves, our heirs, executors, administrators, grantees and assigns amend, modify and alter the foregoing Restrictive Covenants and Conditions as follows:

Paragraph Numbered 1 of the existing Restrictive Covenants and Conditions now recorded in Volume 930 at Page 439 et seq of the Deed Records of Brazoria County, Texas is WELLBORN, BRITT Changed and amended, and shall hereafter read and be as follows:

1. No part of said land above described shall be used or occupied for any purposes other than that of a private single family residence and such things that ordinarily pertain to a private residence, save and except for Lot 1 in Block 1, Lots 1 through 11, inclusive, in Block 6, Lots 7 through 12, inclusive, in Block 9, Lot 5 in Block 2, Lots 7 to 12, inclusive, in Block 3, Lots 9 to 12, inclusive, all of which lots may be used for business or commercial purposes, provided that no noxious or offensive trades or activities shall be carried on there, nor shall any of said lots be used or occupied for or by a business or commercial enterprise selling or distributing alcoholic beverages that are or may be consumed on the premises, and all such alcoholic beverages sold by any such commcercial enterprises must be consumed off of such premises.

The foregoing covenant, condition and restriction shall run and be binding upon said premises for a period of twenty-five (25) years from the date of recording of the original covenants and conditions, after which times said covenant and condition shall be automatically extended for successive periods of ten (10) years, unless an instrument in writing signed by a majority of the then owners of the lots within said Subdivision has been recorded agreeing to change said covenants in whole or in part.

Allof the Restrictive Covenants and Conditions covering said Hickory Creek Place as set forth in Volume 930 at Page 439 et seq of the Deed Records of Brazoria County, Texas shall remain of full force and effect as therein originally made and set forth, and shall be bind-

ing upon all of the properties lying within said Subdivision, WELLBORN, SRIT
