Be Informed Know Your Carpet

Carpet is one of the most widely used floor coverings in the country, and for good reason. It is beautiful, durable, and available in many different textures, types, and colors. As with all floor coverings, there are characteristics of carpet that you need to know. While most Wisenbaker carpets have stain protectors, no carpet is stain proof.

Seams will be visible. Seams will be more visible in a lighter colored carpet than in a darker one.
All carpet shows tracks. We offer some textured carpets that track "less", but not "track proof".
Colors and shades do vary from one dye lot to another.
Some carpet styles will shed after installation for a period of time. This "fuzz" is normal.
A common characteristic of filament base carpet is described as "cornrowing". Continuous filament carpet reduces the concerns with common shedding, but in turn allows the lines between the tufts to be more visible. In higher density carpets, visible "cornrowing" will diminish.
Use an upright vacuum cleaner for routine cleaning. (at least twice a week under normal use).
Hot water extraction (steam cleaning) is the industry preferred method of professional cleaning. Insist on truck mounted equipment.
Application of stain resist chemical offered by in home cleaning companies WILL void any stain resist warranties.

	Blinds installed in a contoured window only cover the rectangular portion of the window opening. The arched portion will be left open.
	_Windows larger than 72" wide by 48" long will consist of more than one blind set side by side in the window opening with one common valence.
	Color dye lots may vary from sample swatch to actual installed blind or shutter.
	Capri blinds have a 1 year limited warranty as long as the blind remains in the original window opening. The warranty is non-transferable.
	_Warranties will be void in the event of accident, negligence, alteration, misuse, abuse, improper handling, or inadequate maintenance.
	Cleaning of blinds and shutters is easy and should be done on a regular basis. Clean with a dry, clean feather duster or cleaning cloth. For deeper cleaning, vacuum gently with the brush attachment of the vacuum cleaner.

We are delighted that you have decided to invest in our quality products to enhance your home. Beautiful wood grain is not manufactured. As a product of many years of natural growth, variations in color and graining showcase the priceless handy work of nature.

Please read the following information. It describes factors which we cannot control and for which we cannot be held responsible.

Wood Characteristics: Color, Grain, and Markings

Finishes are used to enhance and protect wood surfaces. A common misconception is that applying a finish to wood will hide inherent inconsistencies. Actually, the opposite is true; the finish will accentnate any variations.

Wood is not a manufactured material. It is a product of nature. Therefore, its appearance can be influenced by many factors uncontrolled by man (or cabinet company):

- *The tree's sapwood (outer, living part) is often distinctly different in color from its heartwood (inner, dormant part).
- *Small pin knots and some larger knots can form during the tree's natural priming process of eliminating adventitious buds & limbs.
- *Most woods have a uniform texture and are generally straight grained, but can also have "curly", "fiddle-back", "tiger-stripe", and or "birds-eye" patterns.
- *Certain soil factors can cause variation in wood color.
- *Other natural circumstances, including weather conditions or the intrusion of living things such as insects or vines can cause discolorations and wounds. The tree over time will heal itself and incorporate these features into the wood.

Since natural events such as these are responsible for the most of the inherit features or imprints found in the wood, no tree will be completely free of them. Samples should be considered as guides. Variations in color, grain and markings from sample to finished cabinet may not be noticeable and are considered natural characteristics of wood. These variations enhance the natural beauty, depth and individuality of the product.

Color Changes with Age

All finishing products that are used contain UV screens to diminish the result of ultraviolet radiation. Even though the most chemically advanced screening products are used, exposing the cabinets to light, particularly sunlight, will cause the finish to yellow or darken to some degree. Because this effect increases with time, we cannot guarantee exact color matching for replacement parts ordered long after the original job was installed.

Care & Maintenance

- *Never use a dishcloth to clean or dry a cabinet. Detergent residue or grease may be present. Avoid any excessive moisture, clean spills immediately.
- *Never use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or powdered cleansers.
- *Use a clean damp cloth, immediately dry with a clean lint free cotton cloth.
- *Wax or silicone polishes can not be used on Spinel (White Thermal-Foil) Cabinets. Extensive use of these products on stained cabinets may damage the finish and void your warranty.

Know Your TrustPoint Granite Countertop

Congratulations on choosing TrustPoint[™] granite for your new countertops. Before you finalize your decision, please read this document to become more familiar with the natural characteristics of this product. Please initial each item and sign at the bottom.

Choose granite for your countertops if you love the beauty of <u>natural variation within and between counter pieces</u> and are <u>willing</u> to invest some time and energy maintaining its good looks.
Since granite is a natural product, with inherent beautiful natural variety, the characteristics of a particular sample will not be uniformly present in other samples of the same color. A sample serves only to indicate, in a general way, the color, markings, and texture (fissure and pits) usually found in a block of granite. The samples you view may have been quarried at different times and may come from different areas of the quarry than the slabs used in your home; therefore, the sample will not match and may actually be quite different from the product installed in your home.
Since granite is a natural product, characteristics such as color, pattern, texture and veining will vary from kitchen to kitchen. This variet is part of what makes granite so desirable and attractive. Many colors have significant variety within a kitchen, such that individual pieces within a kitchen will vary in shading, coloring and or pattern from each other. The countertops or areas of the countertops within not be replaced due to these variations within or between the pieces of your installation. If granite tile is used on the backsplash fireplace or as inserts in the floor or backsplash, it will not match the slab countertops.
Because granite is natural and is quarried from the ground, it contains inherent characteristics: Hairline cracks (caused during the quarrying process and are visible) Fissures (a natural cleft in the formation which are mistaken for a crack) Pits (small crystals that loosen and may fall out during polishing leaving small voids in the surface)
 Inclusions (areas of stone which do not look like the rest of the stone and may vary in size from small to countertop size). Some colors have a "grain" or pattern direction. This grain or pattern will probably not match at seams, at separate counters and at leve / height changes. Some grained or patterned colors will also change color or appearance, due to different light reflection, when the grain or pattern direction changes.
Any movement of cabinets, walls or general settling of your home could cause any of these hairline cracks, fissures or pits to ope and/or become noticeable. The Marble Institute of America deems it appropriate to repair any surface blemishes or cracks during the fabrication and installation process.
Granite is quarried from the ground. It is impossible to do seamless or seemingly seamless installations of countertops. Granite counterto seams can be seen and felt. Granite slabs are not always perfectly flat causing some seams to be uneven from front to back. Granite slabs frequently vary in thickness from one end to another +/- 1/8". When this occurs, the thicker slab will be feathered to match the thinner slab at the edge seam location.
Since it is a quarried material, slab sizes are random. The maximum guaranteed size of a countertop will be 113" x 68". Occasional random counters may exceed this dimension by a few inches but the increased size is not guaranteed from house to house. When necessary, seams may be included in the sink or cook top cutouts. Seam locations will vary from house to house and homes of the same model may not have seams in the same location. Seam locations will not be reviewed or guaranteed. Overhangs in excess of 10 require corbels, posts or other support installed by the builder.
Being porous, traditional unsealed granite countertops may absorb many types of liquids and will be prone to staining. To resist stains all TrustPoint Granite countertops are sealed with the StainShield-15 sealer. This proprietary stain technology is incorporated into all TrustPoint Granite slabs during the production process. StainShield-15 makes your granite countertops low maintenance an easier to clean (consult regular Care & Maintenance information). Unlike most granites, TrustPoint Granite with StainShield-15 protection does not require yearly sealing for up to 15 years and carries a 15 year Limited Stain Warranty (consult Warrant document).
The polished finish of Granite is very durable and natural, no topical coating is applied, however, it can be scratched with other househol items. The finish may be dulled with the application of unapproved cleaning agents and general wear. Absolutely do not use abrasiv cleansers (such as Comet, Ajax, Soft Scrub, Bon Ami etc.,) on granite surfaces and avoid other cleaners not specific for granite. Test any new cleaner on a small out-of-the-way area before using on the countertop.
