- **BEGINNING:** at a 1/2" iron rod with cap found in the south right of way line of F.M. Highway 532 and at the northwest corner of an 18.777 acre tract conveyed to Larry and Beverly Charles by deed recorded in Volume 353, Page 602 of the Official Records of Lavaca County, Texas, for the northeast corner of this herein described tract;
- **THENCE:** S 14°26'54" E -1936.70 feet along the west line of said 18.777 acre tract and the east line of this herein described tract to a point in the north line of a 223.722 acre tract conveyed to Clinton Ulbig and at the southwest corner of said 18.777 acre tract, for the southeast corner of this herein described tract, whence a 1/2" iron rod with cap found bears N 01° 43' 39" W 0.37 feet;
- **THENCE:** S 68°21'36" W -360.70 feet along the south line of this herein described tract to a point at the southeast corenr of an 18.765 acre tract conveyed to Annie Elizabeth Neumeyer by deed recorded in Volume 164, Page 12 of the Official Records of Lavaca County, Texas, for the southwest corner of this herein described tract, whence a 1/2" iron rod with cap found bears N 04°12'46" W 0.41 feet;
- **THENCE:** N 17°26'03" W -2066.59 feet along the east line of said 18.765 acre tract and the west line of this herein described tract to a 3/4" iron pipe found in the south right of way line of said F.M. Highway 532 and at the northeast corner of said 18.765 acre tract, for the northwest corner of this herein described tract;

THENCE: along the south right of way line of said F.M. Highway 532 and the north line of this herein described tract with the following calls:

THENCE: S 89°20'39" E -115.85 feet to a 1/2" iron rod with cap;

THENCE: N 87°24'38" E -119.31 feet to a 1/2" iron rod with cap;

THENCE: N 83°34'45" E -119.28 feet to a 1/2" iron rod with cap;

THENCE: N 80°38'09" E -119.26 feet to the *POINT OF BEGINNING* containing within these metes and bounds a 18.79 acre tract, more or less.
