- 4 If you are the engineer issuing notification of compliance for the property described on the face of this certificate, furnish this certificate to the **OWNER** and keep a copy.

IMPORTANT: Any changes, additions, modifications, or repairs to this property of a structural nature will require another inspection and certificate to retain eligibility for windstorm and hail insurance through the Texas Windstorm Insurance Association.
