Jackson Survey, Abstract No. 66, being a portion of a called 150 3/5 acre tract described in that deed dated July 17, 2012, from Anna Marie Bosse, et vir to David Bosse and Tammy Bosse, recorded in Volume 1410, Page 0110, Official Records of Washington County, Texas, said 77.08 acre tract being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a found 3/8 inch iron rod at fence corner, lying in the Southerly margin of Old Navasota Road (public right-of-way), lying in the occupied North line of the original called 150-3/5 acre tract (hereafter referred to as "original tract"), marking the Northeast corner of the Paul Bosse, et al called 78.65 acre tract (Volume 1410, Page 0114, Official Records of Washington County, Texas), and marking the Northwest corner of the herein described tract;
