FAST-GROWTH

- Lamar CISD is the 6th fastest-growing school district in Texas;
- Lamar CISD is projected to add over 41,000 new single family homes over the next decade;
- Lamar CISD ranked #3 (out of 61 Houston area school districts) for most housing starts in 2016;

FINANCES

- Lamar CISD has one of the lowest tax rates in the area at \$1.399—this tax rate has remained flat for seven straight years;
- · For the 17th straight year, the Association of School Business Officials (ASBO) International has awarded Lamar CISD its Financial Reporting Certificate of Excellence for having met or exceeded the program's high standards for accountability;
- · Lamar CISD received a 5-Star Rating from the Texas Comptroller, indicating it's in the top 20 percent of the state in student academic growth, while displaying low financial spending.

- Lamar CISD caps elementary enrollment at 750 students and high school enrollment at 2,000 students—allowing more opportunities for students to participate in campus activities;
