

FIELD NOTES
OF A SURVEY OF

Lot Seven (7) out of the Herbert Bell, an unrecorded subdivision in Galveston County, Texas and being more fully described by metes and bounds as follows:

All that certain tract or parcel of land out of the W. J. Jones; Abstract #107 and the H. M. Trueheart Survey in Galveston County, Texas and being part of Lot 2 of the W. J. Jones Survey described by metes and bounds as follows;

COMMENCING at the Northeast corner of a tract of land conveyed to H. Bell by Mamie Bell, a widow, and Catherine Bell, a female, of record in Volume 876, Pages 222-223, in the Office of the County Clerk of Galveston County, Texas, said point being also the Northeast corner of said Lot 2;

Thence South 89°12'00" West, a distance of 32.00 feet to a point for corner;

Thence South 00°43'00" East, a distance of 327.30 feet to a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch iron rod found marking the northeast corner and POINT OF BEGINNING of the herein described tract on the West line of South Bell (R.O.W. Verico);

Thence from said beginning point South 89°17'00" West, a distance of 100.00 feet to a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch iron rod set for corner; from which a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch iron pipe (found) bears S 81°19'51" W - 2.84 feet;

Thence South 00°43'00" East, a distance of 50.00 feet to a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch iron rod set for corner;

Thence North 89°17'00" East, a distance of 100.00 feet to a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch iron rod set for corner on the West line of South Bell;

Thence North 00°43'00" West, along said West line, a distance of 50.00 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

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
