



0.163 Acres (Called Tract 145 of The City of Madisonville) J. S. Hunter Survey, A-110 Madison County, Texas

Being 0.163 acres of land within of The City of Madisonville, also located in the J. S. Hunter Survey, A-110, Madison County, Texas, according to the recorded deed thereof in Volume 1037, Page 306 of the Deed Records of Madison County, Texas, said 0.163 acres being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

BEGINNING at a 1/2" iron rod found at the southeast corner of said 0.163 acres, same being the southwest corner of a 0.1636 acre tract described in volume 907, page 34 of the Madison County Deed Records, Madison County, Texas, and being the POINT OF BEGINNING of the herein described tract;

THENCE South 61 degrees 25 minutes 39 seconds West, with the north line of Bank Street a distance of 74.89 feet to a 1/2" iron rod found for the southwest corner of herein described tract;

THENCE North 25 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds West, a distance of 95.15 feet to a 1/2" iron rod set for the northwest corner of herein described tract;

THENCE North 61 degrees 25 minutes 39 seconds East, a distance of 74.89 feet to a 1/2" iron rod found for the most northeast corner of herein described tract:

THENCE South 25 degrees 00 minutes 00 seconds East, with the west line of a 0.1636 acre tract deeded to Theresa Davis and Lois Price in volume 907, page 34 of the Madison County Deed Records, Madison County, Texas, a distance of 94.15 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING of herein described tract containing 0.163 acres of land;
