Fieldnotes for a survey of a 0.5388 acre tract of land out of a 1.3775 acre tract, in the Joseph Miller Survey, Abstract No. 50, Harris County, Texas, said 0.5388 acre tract being that same property described in deed recorded under Film Code 532-00-1152 of the Official Property Records of Harris County, Texas, and being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

COMMENCING at a 5/8 inch iron rod found at the northwest corner of said 1.3775 acre tract, located at the intersection of the easterly right-of-way line of F. M. Road 2978 and the southerly line of a Missouri Pacific Railroad right-of-way;

THENCE S 56 deg. 43 min. 36 sec. E, 282.88 feet along the north line of said 1.3775 acre tract and southerly line of said Missouri Pacific Railroad right-of-way, a distance of 680.93 feet to a 5/8 inch iron pipe found at the northwest corner and POINT OF BEGINNING of the herein described tract;

THENCE S 56 deg. 43 min. 36 sec. E, 680.93 feet along the north line of said 1.3775 acre tract and southerly line of said Missouri Pacific Railroad right-of-way to a 5/8 inch iron rod found at the east corner of said 1.3775 acre tract and the herein described tract, and being the intersection of said southerly line of the Missouri Pacific Railroad right-of-way and the northerly right-of-way line of Kuykendahl-Huffsmith Road, 80 feet wide;

THENCE in westerly direction along said northerly right-of-way line of Kuykendahl-Huffsmith Road, following the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 1952.00 feet and central angle of 18 deg. 21 min. 48 sec., an arc distance of 625.62 feet (chord = N 65 deg. 55 min. 00 sec. W, 622.94 feet) to a point being the southwest corner of the herein described tract;

THENCE N 00 deg. 16 min. 51 sec. W, 119.38 feet along the west line of the herein described tract, and across said 1.3775 acre tract, to the POINT OF BEGINNING, and containing 0.5388 acre (23,470 square feet) of land.
