#### **LEGAL DESCRIPTION**

## NATHANIEL ALLEN LEAGUE ABSTRACT NO. 2

#### **TYLER COUNTY, TEXAS**

## **52.446 ACRES**

**BEING** a 52.446 acre tract of land out of the Nathaniel Allen League, Abstract No. 2, Tyler County, Texas, and being all of the following properties:

- Called 12.02 acre tract of land as described in Special Warranty Deed dated March 23, 2015, recorded in Volume 1120, Page 679 of the Official Public Records of Tyler County, Texas;
- Called 2.405 acre tract of land as described in Special Warranty Deed dated June 17, 2015, recorded in Volume 1126, Page 61 of the Official Public Records of Tyler County, Texas; and
- Remainder of the called 50-acre tract of land as described in Special Warranty Deed dated June 17, 2015, recorded in Volume 1126, Page 65 of the Official Public Records of Tyler County, Texas, the said 52.446 acre tract of land being more particularly described as follows:

**BEGINNING** at a concrete monument found at the northwest corner of the above referenced 50-acre tract of land;

**THENCE S 80°23'44" E,** with the north line of the above referenced 50-acre tract of land, traversing in part in County Road 3610, a distance of **639.46 feet** to a concrete monument found in the southerly margin of County Road 3610 at the northwest corner of the above referenced 2.405 acre tract of land, from which concrete monument a 1/2" iron rod found at the southwest corner of the said 2.405 acre tract of land bears S 05°16'41" W, a distance of 365.81 feet;

**THENCE S 79°20'30"** E, continuing with the north line of the above referenced 50-acre tract of land and the north line of the above referenced 2.405 acre tract of land, crossing the said County Road 3610 and traversing with the northerly side of the said road, a distance of **312.37 feet** to a 1/2" iron rod found at the northeast corner of the said 2.405 acre tract of land;

**THENCE S 78°19'17" E,** continuing with the north line of the above referenced 50-acre tract of land and traversing with the northerly side of the said road, a distance of **219.91 feet** to a 1/2" iron rod found for the northwest corner of the above referenced 12.02 acre tract of land;

**THENCE S 78°01'53" E,** continuing with the north line of the above referenced 50-acre tract of land and with the north line of the above referenced 12.02 acre tract of land, still traversing with or near the northerly margin of the said road, a distance of **372.05 feet** to a 1/2" iron rod found in the southwesterly margin of F.M. Highway 256 for the northeasterly angle corner of the said 12.02 acre tract of land;

**THENCE S 49°31'14" E,** with the northeast line of the above referenced 12.02 acre tract of land and traversing with the southwesterly margin of F.M. Highway 256, a distance of **351.31 feet** to a 1/2" iron pipe found for the northeast corner of a called 2.10 acre tract of land described in Volume 924, Page 277;

**THENCE S 76°41'08" W,** with the north line of the said 2.10 acre tract of land, a distance of **99.76 feet** to a 1/2" iron pipe found for the northwest corner of the said 2.10 acre tract of land;

**THENCE S 19°52'07"** E, with the west line of the said 2.10 acre tract of land, a distance of **262.61 feet** to a 1/2" iron pipe found for the southwest corner of the 2.10 acre tract of land and the northwest corner of a called 1.00 acre tract of land described in Volume 998, Page 241 of the Official Public Records of Tyler County, Texas:

THENCE S 19°46'06" E, with the west line of the said 1.00 acre tract of land, a distance of 180.54 feet to an old iron bolt found in the northerly margin of U.S. Highway 190 for the southwesterly corner of the said 1.00 acre tract of land, same being the most southerly east corner of the above referenced 12.02 acre tract of land;

THENCE S 67°32'21" W, with the southerly line of the above referenced 12.02 acre tract of land and traversing with the northwesterly margin of U.S. Highway 190, a distance of 774.08 feet to an old iron bolt found in the northerly margin of U.S. Highway 190 for the southwesterly corner of the said 12.02 acre tract of land;

THENCE S 65°53'00" W, with the northwesterly margin of U.S. Highway 190, a distance of 321.07 feet to a 1/2" iron rod set for the southeasterly corner of a called 1.064 acre tract of land described in Volume 619, Page 131 of the Official Public Records of Tyler County, Texas;

THENCE N 24°09'11" W, with the northeasterly line of the said 1.064 acre tract of land, a distance of 219.26 feet to a 5/8" iron rod found for the northeasterly corner of the 1.064 acre tract of land;

THENCE S 65°33'45" W, with the northwesterly line of the said 1.064 acre tract of land, a distance of 210.90 feet to a 5/8" iron rod found for the northwesterly corner of the 1.064 acre tract of land;

THENCE S 24°48'48" E, with the southwesterly line of the said 1.064 acre tract of land, a distance of 214.49 feet to a 1/2" iron rod set in the northwesterly margin of U.S. Highway 190 for the southwesterly corner of the 1.064 acre tract of land;

THENCE S 69°03'05" W, with the northwesterly margin of U.S. Highway 190, a distance of 403.88 feet to a State of Texas concrete highway right-of-way monument;

THENCE S 67°06'25" W, continuing with the northwesterly margin of U.S. Highway 190, a distance of 79.73 feet to a 1/2" iron rod set in the southerly bank of a branch for the most southerly south corner of the herein described tract of land, same being the east corner of a called 1.73 acre tract of land described in Volume 771, Page 163 of the Official Public Records of Tyler County, Texas and from which iron rod a State of Texas concrete highway right-of-way monument found bears S 67°06'25" W, a distance of 19.48 feet;

THENCE with the southerly bank of the said branch, same being the northerly bounds of the said 1.73 acre tract of land, as follows:

- 1) N 38°36'08" W, a distance of 37.31 feet;
- 2) N 75°45'16" W, a distance of 63.35 feet;
- 3) N 44°46'31" W, a distance of 63.68 feet;
- 4) \$ 57°50'18" W, a distance of 46.08 feet;
- 5) N 78°49'46" W, a distance of 13.19 feet;
- 6) N 42°32'00" W, a distance of 35.42 feet;
- 7) N 52°54'54" W, a distance of 44.03 feet;
- 8) N 35°40'50" W, a distance of 30.60 feet;
- 9) S 39°21'04" W, a distance of 31.48 feet;
- 10)S 16°30'43" E, a distance of 21.28 feet;
- 11)S 78°01'36" W, a distance of 33.65 feet;
- 12) N 35°52'38" W, a distance of 58.78 feet:
- 13) N 60°15'26" W, a distance of 55.61 feet;
- 14)\$ 28°58'37" W, a distance of 68.98 feet; 15)S 83°45'22" W, a distance of 32.49 feet;
- 16)N 44°08'30" W, a distance of 57.88 feet; 17)N 24°43'55" W, a distance of 24.08 feet;
- 18)N 08°20'56" W, a distance of 46.95 feet;
- 19) N 39°03'57" W, a distance of 5.71 feet to a 1/2" iron rod set for the north corner of the said 1.73 acre tract of land and a southwesterly corner of the herein described tract of land, from which iron rod a concrete monument found in the northwesterly margin of U.S. Highway 190 for the south, or southwesterly, corner of the above referenced 50-acre tract of land bears S 13°00'56" W, a distance of 521.90 feet and a spike found bears N 86°55'20" W, a distance of 29.48 feet;

**THENCE N 13°00'56"** E, with the west line of the above referenced 50-acre tract of land, a distance of **1456.27 feet** to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, and containing within these bounds an area of **52.446 acres of land**.

NOTE: The bearings cited herein are rotated to the monumented west line of a called 60-acre tract of land as described in Volume 107, Page 110 of the Deed Records of Tyler County, Texas.
