It is noteworthy because of the builder's attention to detail, e.g. flared gable eaves, 20-over-1 windows, corner eave brackets. Strong Craftsman details with some Colonial Revival influence further strengthen its otherwise simple domestic architectural features. Retired cotton planter, John H. Shoaf, and his wife, both from Caldwell County, Texas purchased this tract in 1910 and are believed to have built the house around 1912. In 1919, the property was sold Mrs. Daisy M. Shively, and her husband, Charles E. 
