

> METES AND BOUNDS DESCRIPTION OF A 27.55 ACRE TRACT OF LAND BEING ALL OF THAT CALLED 28.065 ACRE TRACT OF LAND DESCRIBED IN DEED TO JOHN W. EDGAR AND ANNA MARIE EDGAR RECORDED IN VOLUME 1877, PAGE 1381 OF THE OFFICIAL RECORDS OF FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS (O.R.F.B.C.,TX) AND SITUATED IN THE JOSEPH M MCCORMICK SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 57 IN FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS. SAID 27.55 ACRE TRACT BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED BY METES AND BOUNDS AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING 5/8 inch iron rod found in the north line of Battle Road and the south line of a called 68.58 acre tract of land described in deed to W. I. Alton et al. recorded in Volume 194, Page 636 of the Deed Records of Fort Bend County, Texas (D.R.F.B.C.,TX) marking the most northerly corner of said 28.065 acre tract and the most westerly corner of a called 3.031 acre tract of land described in deed to Abraham D. Alcala recorded in Instrument No. 2010117092 of the Official Public Records of Fort Bend County, Texas (O.P.R.F.B.C.,TX) from which a railroad spike found near the intersection of Battle Road with Alton Road bears North 58 degrees 24 minutes 11 seconds East 1,378.55 feet;

THENCE with the southwest line of said 3.031 acre tract and the northeast line of sad 28.065 acre tract South 32 degrees 58 minutes 57 seconds East 874.37 feet to a $5 / 8$ inch iron rod found in a north line of a called 18.156 acre tract of land described in deed to Anala, Inc. recorded in Instrument No. 2002064007 O.P.R.F.B.C.,TX marking the most easterly corner of said 28.065 acre tract and the most southerly corner of said 3.031 acre tract;

THENCE with the southeast line of said 28.065 acre tract and the northwest line of said 18.156 acre tract South 58 degrees 27 minutes 23 seconds West at $1,675.71$ feet passing a $5 / 8$ inch iron rod found for reference and continuing in all a total distance of $1,917.02$ feet to the east bank of the San Bernard River;

THENCE with the east bank of the San Bernard River the following sixteen (16) courses:

1. South 68 degrees $\mathbf{0 2}$ minutes $\mathbf{5 7}$ seconds West 108.29 feet;
2. South $\mathbf{7 5}$ degrees 41 minutes 42 seconds West 133.96 feet;
3. South $\mathbf{7 7}$ degrees $\mathbf{4 3}$ minutes $\mathbf{2 6}$ seconds West 119.55 feet;
4. South $\mathbf{7 0}$ degrees $\mathbf{2 7}$ minutes $\mathbf{2 6}$ seconds West 109.08 feet;
5. South 45 degrees 06 minutes 12 seconds West 97.97 feet;
6. South $\mathbf{5 7}$ degrees $\mathbf{5 6}$ minutes 08 seconds West $\mathbf{7 9 . 1 0}$ feet;
7. South 63 degrees 01 minutes 50 seconds West 81.74 feet;
8. South $\mathbf{7 3}$ degrees $\mathbf{3 4}$ minutes $\mathbf{1 2}$ seconds West 163.69 feet;
9. South $\mathbf{7 7}$ degrees $\mathbf{4 6}$ minutes 05 seconds West 105.54 feet;
10. South 80 degrees 42 minutes 46 seconds West 75.29 feet;
11. North 78 degrees 29 minutes 49 seconds West 48.84 feet;
12. North 62 degrees 32 minutes 18 seconds West 16.00 feet;
13. North 23 degrees 31 minutes 40 seconds West 21.02 feet;
14. North 21 degrees 39 minutes 29 seconds East 47.53 feet;
15. North 54 degrees 02 minutes 31 seconds East 65.11 feet;
16. North 45 degrees 18 minutes 53 seconds East 41.20 feet;

THENCE with a northwest line of said 28.065 acre tract and the southeast line of Timber Lot 28 as shown in the Kendall Subdivision recorded in Volume 11, Page 423 D.R.F.B.C.,TX the following two (2) courses:

1. North 56 degrees 32 minutes 35 seconds East 1,373.70 feet to a set $5 / 8$ inch iron rod with cap stamped "RPLS 6229";
2. North 58 degrees $\mathbf{2 7}$ minutes $\mathbf{2 3}$ seconds East 959.44 feet to a found 1 inch iron pipe marking the most easterly corner of said Timber Lot 28 and an interior corner of said 28.065 acre tract;

THENCE with a southwest line of said 28.065 acre tract and the northeast line of said Timber Lot 28 the following two (2) courses:

1. North 31 degrees 54 minutes $\mathbf{2 4}$ seconds West 32.37 feet to a set $5 / 8$ inch iron rod with cap stamped "RPLS 6229";
2. North $\mathbf{3 2}$ degrees $\mathbf{1 2}$ minutes $\mathbf{3 4}$ seconds West at 252.79 feet passing the most northerly corner of Timber Lot 28 and the most easterly corner of Timber Lot 29 and continuing in all a total distance of 473.67 feet to a $3 / 4$ inch iron rod found in the south line of a called 8.121 acre tract of land described in deed to John K. Patton and Frances E. Patton recorded in Volume 1945, Page 2533 O.R.F.B.C.,TX marking the most northerly west corner of said 28.065 acre tract;

THENCE with a northwest line of said 28.065 acre tract North 58 degrees 11 minutes 18 seconds East 503.79 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING of the herein described tract and containing 27.55 acres within these metes and bounds.
