Aluminum Wiring – We have aluminum wiring in a portion of the house--no issues with it.

**Previous Roof Repairs** – We had the roof inspected before our 5 year warranty and they repaired a couple small areas, one leaking into the attic. It was repaired in February of 2022, and the plywood/sheetrock that was damp replaced.

**Previous treatment for termites or WDI** – Yes. When we bought the house, the previous buyer had disclosed drywoods found by the front door. Those were treated. About a year after we moved in, we found termites by the front door frame. It was treated and the front door replaced. In 2021, we found evidence of termites and got an inspection--there were drywoods in the attic. They were treated by Terminix. They did a one-year inspection in March and found no evidence of new termite activity.

**Previous termite or WDI damage repaired** – The front door was replaced--the bottom of the door frame was mostly what was impacted (aluminum door), but we decided it would be a nice upgrade to replace entirely. None of the damage in the attic was significant enough to warrant any type of repair.

\*A single blockable main drain may cause a suction entrapment hazard for an individual.
