 Reference is hereby made to separate descriptions of the subject tracts.

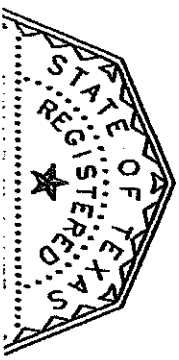
