- Removed elevated platform in foyer so that everything was on one level.
- Custom-designed new solid mahogany front door with flemish glass and side-lites with clear beveled glass.
- Raised hallway entrances and added arch detail
- Added flooring transitions between the black wood-look tile and the pecan wood flooring in the hallways

MASTER BEDROOM + BATHROOM + CLOSET:

Remodel:

- Repainted and new baseboards + casings
- New fan and LED lighting
- Added sliding barn door at entrance to master bath
- Gutted and rebuilt all cabinets.
- Third cabinet and vanity with sink was removed.
- Built in garden tub was gutted and removed and replaced with freestanding tub.
- All new lighting in bathroom
- Speakers in ceiling

- Former shower had large glass block windows which we removed from both the exterior of the shower and from the wall separating the shower and tub. Upon opening the shower walls up, we discovered rotting wood so it all got gutted and rebuilt. We formed 4 separate Flemish glass windows and raised them for privacy from the street. Exterior work included new brick and mortar.
- Redesigned the interior of the shower with new shampoo box and redirected plumbing to one showerhead from the wall. There were originally two shower heads that came out of the walls of the shower (in front of the doors)
- Added shower bench and shampoo box
- Added new glass doors.
- New flooring in the bathroom portion. Original wood floor in closet.
- All new plumbing fixtures, sinks, and toilet
- Replaced all doors. Had closet doors arched to fit the french doors I salvaged.
- Updated LED lighting in master closet

POOL + BACKYARD

- Originally, the pool equipment sat very close to the pool in the middle of the original yard space. We had it replaced and moved to the back of the yard by the fence.
- We redesigned the shape of the patio and made it a much larger space.
- Newly designed flowerbeds with all new landscaping and raised retaining wall behind pool
- New elevated pergola with electricity and ceiling fan.
- Custom designed wood-burning fire pit with surround bench seating
- The original yard was much smaller so we had the original wood fencing removed and made the backyard much larger. New wrought iron fencing and gate.
- Camera security system
- New updated LED recessed lighting and ceiling fan under covered patio
- Wired for an outdoor television
- Designed and installed a washer pit with turf behind the pergola
