
9215 Fordshire Flood Hazard Notes:

During Hurricane Harvey, the residence had an incursion of less than an inch of water.


Since that time the streets in the Woodshire Subdivision have been replaced along with an upgraded storm drainage system.

Harris County Flood Control has recently completed Project Brays which is an extensive flood control and mitigation project that is moving much this area out of the 100 YR flood plain to the 500 YR flood plain. This accomplished thru a Conditional Letter of Map Revision. The 'CLOMR" has been approved and the work is complete. The official revision to the published maps will require a year plus for FEMA to complete. This information can be accessed at Harris County Flood Control's website.
