DESCRIPTION OF A 108.01 ACRE TRACT OF LAND OUT OF THE JOSEPH MCCOY JR. SURVEY, ABSTRACT NO. 68, FAYETTE COUNTY, TEXAS AND BEING ALL OF THAT CALLED 107.977 ACRE TRACT OF LAND DESCRIBED IN A DEED DATED JUNE 12, 2000 FROM SAMUEL I. CAMPION TO ANTHONY J. MITAROTONDO, ET UX, RECORDED IN VOLUME 1101, PAGE 7, OF THE OFFICIAL RECORDS OF FAYETTE COUNTY, TEXAS FOR WHICH REFERENCE IS MADE AND THE SAID 108.01 ACRE TRACT BEING DESCRIBED BY THE METES AND BOUNDS AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING at a 1/2 inch iron rod found (Grid Coordinates: N 13,822,009.67 USft E 2,519,664.50 USft) for the called Southwest corner of the herein described tract, being the common Southerly corner of a called 82.358 acre tract described in a deed dated February 23, 2001 from Samuel I. Campion to David Vaughan Driskell, et ux, recorded in Volume 1125, Page 401, Fayette County Official Records, being also in the common Northeast line of a called 48.104 acre tract described in a deed dated February 16, 2001 from Mike Bruner, et ux to Jeanette Leigh Brukett, recorded in Volume 847, Page 289, Gonzales County Official Records, and being in the called county line between Fayette County and Gonzales County, from said corner a 1/2 inch iron rod found marking the Northerly corner of said 48.104 acre tract bears North 52° 59' 26" West a distance of 730.26 feet:

THENCE North 01° 45' 28" West (called North 00° 08' 54" West) with the Westerly line of the herein described tract, being the common Easterly line of said 82.358 acre tract, passing the Southerly line of F.M. Highway No. 1115 (100' right of way per TxDOT plans) and at 2484.55 feet passing a 1/2 inch iron rod found and called for reference and continuing for a total distance of 2521.46 feet (called 2521.46') to a point in said F.M. Highway No. 1115 for the called Northwest corner of the herein described tract:

THENCE North 88° 29' 40" East (called North 89° 54' 55" East) with the called Northerly line of the herein described tract and being within the limits of said F.M. Highway No. 1115 a distance of 1673.10 feet (called 1673.53') to a point in said F.M. Highway No. 1115 for the called Northeast corner of the herein described

THENCE South 01° 54' 48" East (called South 00° 18' 54" East) with the Easterly line of the herein described tract and at 71.53 feet passing a 1/2 inch iron rod found in the Southerly line of said F.M. Highway No. 1115 (from which a 1/2 inch iron rod found bears North 88° 18' 01" East a distance of 1554.68 feet) and continuing with the Easterly line of the herein described tract, being the common Westerly line of a called 95.212 acre tract described in a deed dated June 19, 1998 from Edward Earl Needham to Ernest Ayres, II, recorded in Volume 1033, Page 700, Fayette County Official Records for a total distance of 1598.07 feet (called 1598.07') to a 1/2 inch iron rod found for the called Southwest corner of said 95.212 acre tract, being the common called Northwest corner of a called 108.257 acre tract described in a deed dated August 12, 1983 from Daniel G. Bellow, et ux to Michael D. Wessels, recorded in Volume 640, Page 328, Fayette County Deed Records:

THENCE with the Westerly line of said 108.257 acre tract (subject tract calls to follow the Westerly line of said 108.257 acre tract), the following:

- South 15° 39' 43" West (called South 18° 17' 00" West, Vol. 640, Pg. 328) a distance of 853.35 feet (called 853.91' per Vol. 640, Pg. 328) to a point in fence;
- South 15° 43' 43" West (called South 18° 21' 00" West, Vol. 640, Pg. 328) a distance of 422.40 feet (called 422.40' per Vol. 640, Pg. 328) to a point in fence;
- South 16° 28' 43" West (called South 19° 06' 00" West, Vol. 640, Pg. 328) a distance of 531.30 feet (called 531.30' per Vol. 640, Pg. 328) to a 1/2 inch iron rod found for the called Southwest corner of said 108.257 acre tract, being the common Northwest corner of a called 28.94 acre tract of land described in a deed dated December 5, 2012 from Helen S. Buckley, Trustee of the Helen S. Buckley

Revocable Trust to Helen S. Buckley, as recorded in Volume 1629, Page 527, Fayette County Official Records, also being the common most Northerly corner of the residue of a called 21.50 acre tract of land described as the First Tract in a deed dated May 4, 2001 from Tracey E. Lewis, et ux to Keith Harold Butler, as recorded in Volume 849, Page 605, Fayette County Official Records;

THENCE South 15° 35' 51" West (called South 18° 06' 12" West) with the Westerly line of said residue of 21.50 acre Butler tract, being the common Easterly line of the herein described tract a distance of 84.30 feet (called 84.79') to a point in a 12" mesquite tree for the Southeast corner of the herein described tract. being an common Northeast corner of a called 92.243 acre tract of land described in a deed dated March 17, 2004 from Gilbert Flores, et ux to Bennie L. Daricek, et ux, as recorded in Volume 901, Page 645, Gonzales County Official Records;

THENCE North 52° 59' 44" West (called North 51° 23' 04" West) with the Northeast line of said 92.243 acre tract, being the common Southwest line of the herein described tract and at 4.95 feet passing a 1/2 inch iron rod found for reference as called for, and at 755.69 feet passing a 1/2 inch iron rod found for the Northerly corner of said 92.243 acre tract, being the common Southeast corner of said 48.104 acre tract, and continuing with the Northeast line of said 48.104 acre tract for a total distance of 1415.36 feet (called 1415.87') to the POINT OF BEGINNING, containing 108.01 acres of land, more or less of which 1.91 acres being in said F.M. Highway, leaving a NET ACREAGE of 106.10 acres of land, more or less.

Bearing Basis: Texas Lambert Grid, Texas South Central Zone, NAD 83/2011 (EPOCH: 2010)

All distances are surface values, to obtain grid values multiply surface distances by a Combined Scale Factor of 0.99987536.

Any reference to a 5/8" iron rod set w/cap is a 5/8" iron rebar 24" inches long and set with a 2" aluminum cap stamped "Frank Surveying Co - TX FIRM #1000100".

This metes and bound description and plat attached hereto represent an on-the-ground survey made under my supervision on July 31, 2015 & August 6, 2015.
