

Windstorm Exemption, Galveston Historical Foundation, 502 20 th Street, Galveston, TX 77550. Forms will be processed by GHF and the City of Galveston then submitted to the Texas Historical Commission for final review and appeals. You will be notified by mail of exemption eligibility within 60 days. Approved applications carry over when ownership changes, there is no need to reapply annually. After the completed form is returned, please send a copy of your approved eligibility form to your insurance agent. You will need a separate exemption for each building 50 years old or older on your property.
