HERRING, ET AL TO LAWRENCE PUCCETTI, SR., ET UX, AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 148, PAGE 525, OF THE DEED RECORDS OF COLORADO COUNTY, TEXAS FOR WHICH REFERENCE IS MADE AND THE SAID 44.526 ACRE TRACT OF LAND BEING DESCRIBED BY METES AND BOUNDS AS FOLLOWS:

BEGINNING at an angle iron found [Grid Coordinates: $N$ 13,801,648.00 USft E 2,701,940.78 USft] in the Northerly line of a called 86.80 acre tract of land described as Tract 1 in a deed dated June 14, 2013 from Estate of Lillie T. Hattermann, Deceased to Helen Albright, as recorded in Volume 756, Page 451, Colorado Count.y Official Records for the Southeast corner of the Southernmost residue of said parent 138.13 acre tract, being the Southwest corner of a called 60.00 acre tract of land described in a deed dated September 27, 2019 from Edwin K. Binder, et al to Bruce Binder, et ux, as recorded in Volume 909, Page 559, Colorado County Official Records;

THENCE South $87^{\circ} 49^{\prime} 09^{\prime \prime}$ West [called South $86^{\circ} 30^{\prime}$ West, Vol. 148, Pg. 525, D.R.C.C.T.] with the Northerly line of said 86.80 acre tract, being the Southerly line of the Southernmost residue of said parent 138.13 acre tract a distance of 550.35 feet to a $5 / 8$ inch iron rod set w/cap for the Southwest corner of the herein described tract, from which a a $5 / 8$ iron rod set w/cap for the Southwest corner of the Southernmost residue of said parent 138.13 acre tract bears South $87^{\circ} 49^{\prime} 09^{\prime \prime}$ West a distance of 966.76 feet;

THENCE South $01^{\circ} 16^{\prime} 23^{\prime \prime}$ East [called South $00^{\circ} 30^{\prime}$ East, Vol. 148 , Pg. 525, D.R.C.C.T.] with the Westerly line of said 8.859 acre tract and the Westerly line of said 60.00 acre tract, being the Easterly line of the Southernmost residue of said parent 138.13 acre tract at 1445.01 feet passing a $5 / 8$ inch iron rod found
