



PEARLAND NEIGHBORHOOD GUIDE



Pearland, named for the area's abundant pear trees back in the 1890's, provides small town charm with easy access to Houston's Downtown and Medical Center and NASA's Johnson Space Center.

Public schools in Pearland have received high marks and the abundant green space is the perfect setting for afterschool play sessions and weekend outings. Silverlake Park offers a Texas flag climbing wall and playgrounds. Gardening enthusiasts will be inspired by the variety of trees, from the exotic Buddha's hand to the ordinary apple, with a walk down Mary's Creek Edible Fruit Trail. The whole family will love Centennial Park where Fitbit fans can make their goals hitting the trails and fitness stations or

playing a round of frisbee golf while the kiddos work up a sweat on the playground before cooling off on the splashpad.

The Pearland Recreation Center & Natatorium is a state-of-the-art facility offering members an elevated indoor track, a weight & cardio room, a spinning & yoga room, indoor basketball and racquetball courts, and 2 indoor pools. You can take advantage of their wide variety of group classes, from Zumba to water aerobics, or personal training packages. Sign up the younger ones or cheer on the Pearland Little League, whose teams have participated in the Little League World Series. Book a tee time on the Champion Bermuda greens at the Southwyck Golf Club.



Chef Ronnie Killen is the master of all things beef and Pearland is home to his trio of restaurants. For special occasions, make a reservation at Killen’s Steakhouse, wait in line at Killen’s Barbecue for the top-rated brisket and beef ribs, or order burgers paired with an old-fashioned milk shake at Killen’s Burgers. For Italian, dine at local favorite, Grazia. Authentic Sichuan dishes are prepared at Pepper Twins. Get your crawfish fix at Atchafalaya Crawfish. Enjoy German fare and beer at King’s Biergarten & Restaurant with live music on the weekends. Cool off in the air-conditioned tap room with a made-in-Pearland craft beer at Bakfish Brewing Co.

Shop for locally grown fruits and veggies, prepared foods, and crafts on the 2nd Saturday of each month at the Pearland Farmer’s Market. Nearby Froberg Farm and Country Store is open 7 days a week selling homegrown fruits and vegetables, with a calendar of events like the Fall Festival’s corn maze and hayrides, plus strawberry-picking from January through May. Tour or volunteer at the Pearland Community Gardens where the first beds were planted in 2010.

Support the local performing arts with season tickets for the Pearl Theatre where aspiring young actors can enroll in classes and summer camp. The Pearland Art League hosts exhibitions and gives art lessons. Visit the peaceful grounds of the Hindu Sri Meenakshi Temple, which is open to the public and holds festivals and events throughout the year. Annual events include the Pearland Opry on the Square, Fourth of July fireworks, and a Christmas Parade.
