- 5941 Total sq ft home. 3442 sq ft living combined with 2499 sq ft outdoor space.
- 4 spacious bedrooms & 3 full baths.
- The double-sided fireplace is either wood burning or propane gas.
- 800 sq ft covered porch with Aesthetic French doors entering the Master bedroom,
 Formal Living room, and den area for convenience.
- 2 Large living spaces that share a double-sided fireplace include the Formal Living room & den.
- The home foundation is constructed on 53 piers that are 1' 4" wide, 9' deep flaring out to 36" wide bell bottoms.
- There is steel tying in from the piers through cement columns into the main beams. There are five main beams measuring 4" x 16" running the length of the home for support and strength. There are 2" x 12" floor joists on 12" centers coming off of each main beam that creates a 3' crawl space under the home for easy access.
- The house pad plus crawl space adds 7' elevation above the lay of the land.
- All plumbing is under the home and all electrical lines to the outlets are from the attic.
- Home was originally designed for a second story, it is constructed with 2" x 12" and 2" x 10" ceiling joists for extra strength.
- 2" x 6" studs on the outer walls results in sturdy construction and plenty of insulation.
- The roof has a hip design structure for each section to create extra strength in case of high winds.
- The attic has radiant barrier installed for energy efficiency.
- The home and roof have been built to withstand the Gulf Coast hurricanes. Every other rafter in the roof has storm straps to give the roof extra integrity.
- Garage doors are insulated to maintain cooler temperatures.
