This house has been extremely efficient with the air conditioning and heater. During the summer it would be 100 degrees outside while the inside of the house was at around 75-80 degrees with no air conditioner running. If the A/C was on and set to 72 degrees, it would run about once an hour to maintain the temperature in the house.

The entire property around the house was regraded to channel rain correctly. When the house was purchased the landscaping and grading were pushing water toward the house which was why the floor got wet in Imelda (20" of rain in 24 hours). That has been corrected. It is NOT in the flood plain and has NOT flooded in any other major storm, including Harvey.
