

Elgin Memorial Park | 1127 Main St.

Elgin Memorial Park was created in the 1930s as a place for soldiers stationed at Camp Swift to reunite with their families under the canopy of cedar elms. Elgin Memorial Park is a community park consisting of 24 forested acres with natural pathways, a ball field, a small concession stand, restrooms, two sand volleyball courts, one basketball court, one tennis court, horseshoe and washer pits, playground, covered and uncovered picnic tables, grills, and scattered park benches. There are also two covered pavilions popular for private rentals and events.

The upgraded playground was made possible by the St. David's Foundation "Parks with a Purpose" grant. Other recreational features were provided by the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department.
