Why the seller loved living at 1414 Finch:

I have lived at 1414 Finch two separate times, first between 2009 to 2010, when it was my Grandma's home, and again from 2021 to 2023 as the owner. This house has been a part of my family for over a decade.

Over those years, this neighborhood has truly changed before my eyes. The area has always had a sense of community, as many of the residents are homeowners as opposed to tenants. Because of this, living in the Northside is hard to beat. There are more and more families and businesses moving into the Northside every day.

In addition to the community, the location has always been desirable, as it's close to just about everything. The home is very central and super accessible to all the major highways sitting between 45 and 69, as well as I-10 and 610. The location is truly unbeatable as my daily commute is approximately 5 minutes down Hardy which puts you right in the center of downtown.

The house itself holds a special place in my historically dedicated heart. It is an honor to own a piece of Houston's preserved history with a home built almost a century ago. This particular house was moved from Harvard Street in the Heights in the early 2000s and restored to the original craftsman style. A lot of the home's elements and fixtures are original and can be seen throughout.
