The following is a duplication of an article that appeared in *The Houston Post* on Sunday, November 30, 1924, at p. 53. The Xerox copy from which this is taken is extremely difficult to read, and perhaps future historians will better understand my typing of it exactly as it appeared in the paper, errors and all.

DRIVE OUT TO WINLOW PLACE TODAY
THANKSGIVING HOME TO BE OPENED TODAY
Winlow Place Company Will Welcome Visitors at Structure During Day.

Officials of the Winlow Place company were so well pleased with the reception given their Thanksgiving home which was opened in Winlow Place last Thursday, that they have decided to again open this attractive residence for public inspection Sunday from 10 a.m. to until 9 p.m. A cordial invitation has been extended the public to inspect this wonderfully designed structure, which has received a lot of merited praise because of its splendid arrangement in architecture.

All afternoon last Thursday when the Thanksgiving home was thrown open from 2 p.m. until 10 p.m., a veritable line of interested persons passed in and out, all of them appearing to be well pleased with what they saw. The bedrooms are all harmonious in their arrangement, the furniture blending perfectly with the decorations, even the pictures which hang upon the walls working smoothly into the layout. The very latest designs of furniture have been used throughout.

On the lower floor is the sitting room, the breakfast room, the breakfast nook, a dainty and enchanting little place, the kitchen, and the entrance hall. To the southeast is a wonderful brick and concrete porch, built for permanence, and arranged so that it gives added beauty to the entire building.

Every modern convenience has been prepared for in the plans for this home, nothing having been overlooked to make it a model, even though officials of the company do not like to call it such. To go through the house is to see what can be done with little money – that is compared to the amount spent in the construction of other types of homes. Officials of the Winlow Place company are more than pleased with the results of their disclosure in carrying out plans in connection with the Thanksgiving home, in which so many people have taken interest.
