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# Notable Features + Amenities

This Braeswood Place 1954 ranch home was lovingly built and cared for by the original owners for over 40 years. In 1996, the current homeowners purchased this gem, becoming only its second caretakers. The house appealed to this young couple as they wanted to establish roots in the same neighborhood that they grew up in and where their extended family also lived. The current family has loved this home for over 27 years due to its proximity to the Med Center, downtown, all-things Rodeo, as well as to church and school communities. This beautifully maintained home has been the perfect place to raise a family in the heart of the city while enjoying an escape to its nearly 20,000 sq. ft. tree-lined lot. The landscaped backyard has been the focal point for many family croquet matches, parties, and children's playdates. The house has inviting features from a wood-burning fireplace in the living room where the family gathers during the holidays to a beautiful wall of French doors and windows offering picturesque views into the park-like backyard. The kitchen opens up to the breakfast area and sunroom which connects outdoors to a paver patio and custom-built carport that doubles as an outdoor entertainment area. The house maintains its original charm and footprint with some modern touches and updates.

- House situated on a 19,553 SF lot with mature oak and pecan trees that have been trimmed/maintained.
- Moonlighting in large backyard oak tree and exterior landscape lighting.
- Electric-controlled wrought iron driveway gate with keypad and remotes and custom fencing on the north side of property.
- All stainless-steel appliances including Bosch dishwasher, wine/beverage refrigerator, side-by-side refrigerator, 40" five-burner gas range with double ovens, GE built-in microwave, as well as washer/dryer, and safe stay with house.
- Monitored home security system.
- House has never flooded through major events of Tropical Storm Allison (2001), Memorial Day (2015) and Tax Day (2016) floods as well as Hurricane Harvey (2017).
- · House has had no foundation issues.
- House has secured FEMA Letter of Map Amendment (LOMA) establishing elevation is outside the 100-year flood plain.
- House is situated across from park area with bayou scenery and accessible walking/biking trails.
