The Miller residence at 1402 Herkimer Street was built in 2018 but appears to date back to the 1920s. This is the first home Bungalow Revival has designed and built from scratch as opposed to their many renovations of existing homes.

Gilbert comments, "This Craftsman Style Bungalow is unique. Although it is new construction, it is filled with all the charm and attention to detail of an original 1920s Bungalow. It is built with all the up-to-date modern amenities of today's lifestyle living. As one walks through this home, the unique floor plan mixes old and new to perfection." With custom built-ins and a center hall, an open feel is created.


