

BEING 3.59 acres (156,541 square feet) of land located in the David Beers Survey, Abstract Number 4 and being out of a 28.957 acre tract of land as surveyed during August 2004 by James Johnson for Kenneth Street and being further out of those certain called 353.87 acre tract and 264.85 acre tract as described in Exhibit A-2 as tract 19 and 20 in a deed from International Paper Company to Oakhurst Acquisition LLC as recorded under Clerk's File Number 02-1571, Page 5805 of the Official Records of San Jacinto County, Texas; Said 3.59 acres being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows with all bearings being referenced to the Texas State Plane Coordinate System, NAD 83;


BEGINNING at a 5/8 inch iron rod with cap stamped "Bourland Surveying", set for the southwest corner of the herein described in the east line of U.S. Forest Service, Tract J-12-B;

THENCE North 46°50′51″ East, along the northwest line of the herein described tract, the southeast line of said Tract J-12-B and the northwest line of said 264.85 acre tract, a distance of 575.27 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with cap stamped "Bourland Surveying", set for the north corner of the herein described tract, having for reference a found concrete monument bearing North 46°50′51″ East, a distance of 768.53 feet for the north corner of said 28.957 acre tract and being the southwest line of a called 2.00 acre tract described in Volume 238, Page 883 of the Deed Records of San Jacinto County, Texas;

THENCE South 57°50′23″ East, over and across said 28.957 acre tract, a distance of 192.33 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with cap stamped "Bourland Surveying", set for the northeast corner in the northwest right of way line of FM 3018;

THENCE along a curve to the left, having the following elements, an arc Length of 513.91 feet, a Radius of 1,518.54 feet, a Delta of 19°23′24″, with a Chord Bearing South 21°54′27″ West, a distance of 511.46 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with cap stamped "Bourland Surveying", set;

THENCE North 64°54′11" West, a distance of 432.51 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, containing 3.59 acres (156,541 square feet) of land in San Jacinto County, Texas.



2.73 Acres San Jacinto County, Texas

BEING 2.73 acres (119,056 square feet) of land located in the David Beers Survey, Abstract Number 4 and being out of a 28.957 acre tract of land as surveyed during August 2004 by James Johnson for Kenneth Street and being further out of those certain called 353.87 acre tract and 264.85 acre tract as described in Exhibit A-2 as tract 19 and 20 in a deed from International Paper Company to Oakhurst Acquisition LLC as recorded under Clerk's File Number 02-1571, Page 5805 of the Official Records of San Jacinto County, Texas; Said 2.73 acres being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows with all bearings being referenced to the Texas State Plane Coordinate System, NAD 83;

BEGINNING at a 5/8 inch iron rod with cap stamped "Bourland Surveying", set for the southwest corner of the herein described tract having for reference a 3/8 inch iron rod, found for northwest corner of a called 66.682 acre tract as recorded under Clerk's File Number 04-6756 of the Official Records of San Jacinto County, Texas and the southwest corner of said 28.957 acre tract in the east line of U.S. Forest Service, Tract J-12-B;

THENCE North 46°50′51″ East, along the northwest line of the herein described tract, the southeast line of said Tract J-12-B and the northwest line of said 264.85 acre tract, a distance of 266.74 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with cap stamped "Bourland Surveying", set for the north corner of the herein described tract;

THENCE South 64°54′11″ East, over and across said 28.957 acre tract a distance of 432.51 feet to a 5/8 inch iron rod with cap stamped "Bourland Surveying", set for the northeast corner in the northwest right of way line of FM 3018;

THENCE along a curve to the left, having the following elements, an arc Length of 185.25 feet, a Radius of 1,518.54 feet, a Delta of 06°59′23″, with a Chord Bearing North 08°43′04″ East, a distance of 185.14 feet to a existing fence post;

THENCE North 79°24'59" West, over and across said 28.957 acre tract, along an existing fence, a distance of 310.62 feet to a fence post;

THENCE North 63°20′27" West, continuing along said fence line, a distance of 282.96 feet to the **POINT OF BEGINNING**, containing 2.73 acres (119,056 square feet) of land in San Jacinto County, Texas.
