Pursuant to V.T.C.A., Texas Water Code, Sections 49.452 and 49.455, as amended, the Board of Directors of Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 144 (the "District") now gives the following Amendment to Information Form and revised Notice to Purchasers form to all sellers and purchasers of real estate situated in the District. We do hereby certify that the only modifications to be made by this Amendment are changes to item number 9, as follows:

- 9. The form of Notice to Purchasers required by Section 49.452, Texas Water Code, which is to be furnished by a seller to a purchaser of real property in the District, is as follows:

**NOTICE TO PURCHASER OF SPECIAL TAXING

The real property that you are about to purchase is located in Harris County Municipal Utility District No. 144 and may be subject to District taxes or assessments. The District may, subject to voter approval, impose taxes and issue bonds. The District may impose an unlimited rate of tax in payment of such bonds. The current rate of the District's property tax is \$0.48 on each \$100 of assessed valuation. The District may impose assessments and issue bonds and impose an assessment in payment of such bonds. The total amount of bonds payable wholly or partly from property taxes, excluding refunding bonds that are separately approved by the voters and any bonds or portions of bonds issued that are payable solely from revenues received or expected to be received under a contract with a governmental entity approved by the voters is \$17,570,000 for water, sewer and drainage facilities. The aggregate principal amount of all such bonds issued is \$7,320,000.

The District is located wholly or partly within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Houston. Texas law governs the ability of a municipality to annex property in the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction and whether a district that is annexed by the municipality is dissolved. The District has entered into a Strategic Partnership Agreement with the City of Houston. This Agreement may address the timeframe, process, and procedures for the municipal annexation of the area of the District located in the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction.

The purpose of this District is to provide water, sewer, drainage, or flood control facilities and services within the District. The cost of the District's facilities is not included in the purchase price of your property.
