KHON ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

THAT, WHEREAS, JORN BOYKIN, JR., HEREAFTER CALLED OWNER, BEING THE OWNER OF A CERTAIN TRACT OF LAND WRICH HAS BEEN HERETOFORE PLATTED AND SUBDIVIDED OUT OF 154.519 ACRES. BEING 79.037 ACRES, SUBDIVIDED OUT OF C. A. FELDER ABSTRACT -21 HARDIN COUNTY, TEXAS, AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 1055, PAGE 587, OF THE PLAT BECORDS, N. M. SLADE ABSTRACT, 454 VOLUME 1056, PAGE 587, C.A. FELDER, AB. 21, AND H.H. SLADE, AB. 454, HARDIN COUNTY, TEXAS, AS RECORDED IN VOLUME 1135, PAGE 598, OF THE PLAT BECONDS, HARDIN COUNTY, TEXAS, AND DO HEREBY ESTABLISH, AND ADOPT AND PROMULBATE THE FOLLOWING RESERVATIONS, BESTRICTIONS, COVENANTS AND EASEMENTS TO APPLY UNIFORMLY TO THE USE, OCCUPANCY AND CONVETANCE OF ALL LOTS IN SAID "STONEGATE" TO THE PENEFIT OF THE PRESENT AND ENTURE OWNERS OF THE SAID LOTS.

- 1. The lots conveyed shall be used only for residential.
- 2. Ho sign or any kind or character shall be allowed on said presided, except one sign of not more than 5 equara feet advertising the property for sale.
- No structure of a temporary character, no trailer
 home mobil home, bent, sheck, gazage or other building
 shall be used on such premises at any time as a residence either temporarily or permanently.
- 4. These presises shall not be used or maintained as a dumping ground for subbish, trash, garbage, or other vaste. The presises shall not be used as a storage place for old lumber, cars and junk of any description, all subbish, trash, garbage, or other waste shall not be kept except in a sanitary container. All incinerators, smaltary containers, or other equipment for the storage or disposal of such materials shall be kept in a clean and sanitary condition.

- No professional, business or commercial activity shall!
 be conducted on said premises.
- 6. No obnoxious or offensive activity shall be carried on upon these premises, nor shall say thing be done thereon which may be or become an annoyance or a nuisence to the neighborhood. The use or discharge of firearns is prohibited on these premises.
- 7. We cattle, hoge, livestock or poultry or any kind shall be reised, bred, or kept on this property. Doge, cats, other household pets may be kept, provided that they are not kept, bred, or maintained for commercial purposes. That they do not become a nulsance or ennoyance to the neighborhood.
- All residences constructed on such property must have at least two thousand square feet of living stee, plus a double car garage.
- 9.. All houses constructed shall be at least half brick on the bottom story.
- Concrete drive-way from garage to atreet with concrete culterts.
- 11. No walls, funce or hedge shall be erected or maintained nearer to the street than the building set back line existing on such lot. NO side or rear fence, wall, or hedge shall be more than eight (8) feet high. Any wall, funce or hedge erected on a lot by "OWNER" or his assigns shall pass ownership with title to the property and it shall be owner's responsibility to maintain said wall, fence or hedge.
- 12. These restrictions and covenants are hereby declared to
 be covenants running with the land and shall be folly
 binding upon all persons acquiring lots in "STONEGATE"
 subdivision whether by descent, devise, purchase, or
 otherwise, and any person by the acceptance of title to
 eny property in said "STONEGATE" subdivision shall thereby
 agreeand covenant to abide by and fully perform the foregoing
 restrictions and covenants. These covenants are to run
 with the land and shall be binding for a period of 25

years from the date hereof: At the end of such period said restrictions and covenants shall automatically be extended for a successive period of ten years unless by a vote of a three-fourths majority of the then owners of the property, each lot having one vote, taken prior to the expiration of wald 25 years period and filed of record in said county. It is agreed to amend or release Kame .

- 13. No parked care, trailers, or any motor vehicle left unattended on streets in "STONEGATE" subdivision no longer than four hours, not any to be left overnight.
- 14. If any person or persons shall violate or attempt to violate any of the restrictions and covenants harein, it shall be lawful, for any person or persons owning property in said "STONEGATE" subdivision to prosecute proceedings at law or in equity against the person violating or attempting to violate any such restrictions and covenants, either to prevent him or them from mo doing or to correct such violation or to recover damages or other relief for such violation.
- 15. Invalidation of anyone of these covenants by judgement or court order shall in no wise affect any of the other provisions which shall remain in full force and effect.
