

AMENDMENT TO AMENDED AND RESTATED
DISTRICT INFORMATION FORM

In compliance with Section 49.455, Texas Water Code, as amended, the undersigned member of the Board of Directors of Clear Brook City Municipal Utility District (the "District") hereby amend the District Information Form for the District as follows:

3. The most recent rate of taxes on property located in the Authority is \$0.51 per \$100 of assessed valuation.

9. The form of Notice to Purchasers required by Section 49.4521 of the Texas Water Code as furnished by a seller to a purchaser of real property in the District, is amended to read as follows:

NOTICE TO PURCHASER OF SPECIAL TAXING OR ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

The real property, described below, which you are about to purchase is located in Clear Brook City Municipal Utility District and may be subject to district taxes or assessments. The district may, subject to voter approval, impose taxes and issue bonds. The current rate of the district property tax is \$0.51 on each \$100 of assessed valuation. The total amount of bonds payable wholly or partly from property taxes, excluding refunding bonds that are separately approved by voters, approved by the voters are:

- (i) \$167,000,000 for water, sewer, and drainage facilities;
- (ii) \$0 for road facilities;
- (iii) \$0 for parks and recreational facilities; and
- (iv) \$4,800,000 for fire improvements.

The aggregate initial principal amounts of all such bonds issued are

- (i) \$ 136,768,964 for water, sewer, and drainage facilities;
- (ii) \$0 for road facilities;
- (iii) \$0 for parks and recreational facilities; and
- (iv) \$4,250,000 for fire improvements.

The district is located wholly or partly in the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Houston. Texas law governs the ability of a municipality to annex property in the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction and whether a district that is annexed by the municipality is dissolved. The district has entered into a strategic partnership agreement with the City of Houston. This agreement may address the timeframe, process, and procedures for the municipal annexation of the area of the district located in the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction.

The purpose of this district is to provide water, sewer, drainage, firefighting, and parks and recreational facilities and services. The cost of the district facilities is not included in the purchase price of your property.

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
