**BEGINNING** at a found 1/2 inch iron rod, with cap and in concrete at the Northerly base of an 8 inch treated fence corner post, for the Westerly or Northwest corner of the called 10.245 acre tract, more or less, mentioned above, the Northerly or Northeast corner of a called 5.00 acre tract, more or less, as described in a Deed to James Trotter, et ux (1266/145) and same being a Southerly angle point in a called 91.390 acre tract, more or less, as described in a Deed to Danny Farmer (1072/701);

THENCE N 42°04'59" E, 709.54 ft., along a fenced and Southeast line of said 91.390 acre Farmer tract (1072/701) and a Northwest line of the called 10.245 acre tract mentioned above to a set 5/8 inch iron rod for the Northerly Northwest corner of the tract of land herein described, from which a found 1/2 inch iron rod, with cap and at the Northerly base of an 8 inch treated fence corner post, for the Northeast corner of said 10.245 acre tract brs. N 42°04'59" E, 203.21 ft.;

THENCE S 59°59'00" E, 163.47 ft., crossing into the called 10.245 acre tract mentioned above to a set 5/8 inch iron rod, in a barbed wire fence line, for an angle point in line for corner;

THENCE S 01°18'25" E, 165.22 ft., along said barbed wire fence line to a set 5/8 inch iron rod for an angle point in line for corner;

THENCE S 29°30'49" E, 420.50 ft., crossing over the called 10.245 acre and 5.431 acre tracts mentioned above to a set 5/8 inch iron rod, 4.7 ft.
