

DESCRIPTION OF A TRACT OF LAND CONTAINING 0.55119 ACRES (24,010 SQUARE FEET) SITUATED IN THE WILLIAM HARDIN LEAGUE SURVEY, ABSTRACT 24 HARRIS COUNTY, TEXAS

Being a tract of land containing 0.55119 acres (24,010square feet), situated in the William Hardin League Survey, Abstract 24, Harris County, Texas, being known as Lot 7, in Briarforest, an unrecorded subdivision in Harris County, Texas, being all of a tract land conveyed unto Jack R. Chiles and Simone K. Chiles by deed record under County Clerk's File No. V257477 of the Official Public Records of Harris County, Texas. Said 0.55119-acre tract being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

COMMENCING at a point in the north right-of-way line of Briar Forest Drive (100.00 feet wide) for the southwest corner of Jerry R. Daniel 21.535 acre tract;

THENCE North, along the east line of 80.00 feet Houston Lighting and Power of a distance of 892.07 feet to a set 1/2-inch iron rod with cap marked "SURVEY 1" for the POINT OF BEGINNING and the southwest corner of the said tract herein described;

THENCE North, continuing along the east line of said Jerry R. Daniel tract a distance of 140.00 feet to a found 1/2-inch iron rod for the northwest corner of the said tract herein described;

THENCE East, a distance of 171.50 to a set 1/2-inch iron rod with cap marked "SURVEY 1" in the west line of Briar Bayou Drive (60.00 feet wide), for the northeast corner of the said tract herein described;

THENCE South, along the west line of Briar Bayou Drive (60.00 feet wide) to a set 1/2-inch iron rod with cap marked "SURVEY 1" for the southeast corner of the said tract herein described;

THENCE West, a distance of 171.50 to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 0.55119 acres (24,010 square feet), more or less.
